CALL FOR PAPERS

The Conference

After *Socratica 2005* and *Socratica 2008* we are pleased to announce a third *Socratica* conference, to be held in cooperation with, and in the premises of, the Università di Trento, Italy, on February 2012.

The conference is meant to deal with Socrates, the Socratics, and the Ancient Socratic Literature. Its scope is to tackle everything that is *around* Plato, a host of topics which usually remain outside the scope of the *Symposia Platonica*.

Time Schedule

About fifteen papers are suitable to be read during the Trento conference.

Call for Papers. The initial submissions for presentation should consist of an abstract of about 500 words, which will be evaluated by a panel of experts from different countries. Deadline: October 10, 2011. Please send your proposal by email to F. de Luise. A final decision about the papers to be read is expected to be taken by November 30, 2011.

Accepted abstracts will be put on the web together with the author's CV (if supplied).

Authors should prepare a tentative full version of their papers by January 15, 2012. Extended papers will be circulated among the participants, while the final version is expected to be delivered to the editorial board by June 30, 2012.

The Conference Proceedings will be edited by F. de Luise and A. Stavru, and form a sequel to the *Socratica 2005* and the *Socratica 2008* proceedings. We hope to have them printed in time for the *Tenth Symposium Platonicum* to be held in Pisa in 2013.

Organization Scheme

The registration fee for participants is 200 euro, covering access to all sessions, 2 lunches, coffee breaks, receptions, conference material, and a copy of the printed proceedings.

If you want to participate without presenting a paper, please get in contact by email with F. de Luise not later than January 2012. Special arrangements will be made with local hotels for a limited number of rooms at a special conference rate.

We plan to host the scheduled speakers with no charge.

Younger participants. A reduced fee will be granted to all younger participants. Moreover, we hope to be able to grant a room and free attendance to some of them, while travel costs will get no support. Detailed information about these facilities will be announced and circulated as soon as possible.
